### Review Process

The EMBA-GSC has one January entry term a year. Applications are reviewed on a rolling basis with priority review for admission and funding given to early applicants. Once submitted, applications are reviewed immediately and a final decision will typically be given within 2-weeks by email, in the application portal, and via phone. If you are admitted, an advisor will connect with you on the next steps.
